
- 7. Remove the oil filter (7) with a filter wrench and let the remaining oil drain out.
- 8. Apply a thin coat of engine oil to the new oil filter rubber seal (8).

Use only the Honda genuine oil filter or a filter of equivalent quality specified for your model. Using the wrong Honda filter or a non-Honda filter which is not of equivalent quality may cause engine damage.

9. Install the new oil filter and tighten it to the specified torque:

26 N·m (2.6 kg-m, 19 lb-ft)


If a torque wrench is not available, tighten the oil filter as follows:

①Install and hand tighten the oil filter fully.

2 Tighten the oil filter 1/12 turns according to the indicator (9) with the oil filter wrench (10).

NOTE:

* Use the numbers (1 to 12) printed on the outer surface as a reference when tightening the oil filter. Turn the oil filter to the next number.
