


## WHEEL REMOVAL

Refer to the Safety Precautions on page 65.

## Front Wheel Removal (Type II)

- 1. Place the motorcycle on its center stand.
- 2. Raise the front wheel off the ground by placing a support block under the engine.
  3. Remove the speedometer cable (1) by
- removing the screw (2).
- 4. Remove the front axle nut cap (3).
- 5. Remove the front axle nut (4).
- 6. Remove the front axle shaft (5), front wheel and side collar.

Do not depress the brake lever when the wheel is off the motorcycle. The caliper pistons will be forced out of the cylinders with subsequent loss of brake fluid. If this occurs, servicing of the brake system will be necessary. See your dealer for this service.
