

## Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tyre, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your motorcycle:

- Fuel level – Fill fuel tank when necessary. ➤ P. 63
- Throttle – Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. ➤ P. 110
- Engine oil level – Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➤ P. 98
- Coolant level – Add coolant if required. Check for leaks. ➤ P. 102

- Brakes – Check operation; Front and Rear: check brake fluid level and pads wear. ➤ P. 104, 105
- Lights and horn – Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
- Engine stop switch – Check for proper function.
- Clutch – Check clutch fluid level. ➤ P. 107
- Side stand ignition cut-off system – Check for proper function. ➤ P. 108
- Wheels and tyres – Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. ➤ P. 81
