

## //////PRE-DRIVING INSPECTION//////

Make it a practice to perform a general inspection of the ODYSSEY before riding. This inspection will take only a few minutes and can save you much time and expense.

- Fuel – Check the quantity of fuel remaining in the fuel tank. Refill if necessary.
- Brakes – Check operation and free play of both brakes. Adjust if necessary.
- Tire Pressure – Check tire pressures. Recommended Pressure: Front 0.35kg/cm<sup>2</sup> (5.0psi)  
Rear 0.21kg/cm<sup>2</sup> (3.0psi)
- Roll Bar – Check for cracks, deformities and loosening of connections.
- Seat Belt – Check anchors, fasteners and belts for loosening, wear and fraying. Replace if necessary.
- Drive Belt – Check for damage or excessive wear and replace if necessary.
- Headlight/Taillight – Check headlight and taillight. Replace any bulb that fails to function.
- Throttle – Check for smooth operation and proper travel when it is squeezed and ensure that it returns smoothly when released. Adjust if necessary.
- Nuts, Bolts, and Fittings – Check wheels to see that axle nuts are tight. Check security of all other nuts, bolts, and fittings.

**NOTE: A safety inspection is recommended periodically or anytime structural damage is suspected.**
