

MAINTENANCE

FUSE REPLACEMENT

Refer to the Safety Precautions on page 131.

When frequent fuse failure occurs, it usually indicates a short circuit or an overload in the electrical system. See your dealer for repair.

NOTICE

Never use a fuse with a different rating from that specified. Serious damage to the electrical system or a fire may result, causing a dangerous loss of lights or engine power.

Recommended Fuses:

Main fuse A: 30 A
Main fuse B/External amplifier fuse: 120/40 A

Circuit fuses: 30 A, 20 A, 15 A, 10 A, 5 A

The fuse box (including spare fuses) is located behind the left side cover. The main fuse is located in the fuse box.

- 1. To prevent an accidental short circuit, turn the ignition switch OFF before checking or replacing the fuses.
- 2. Remove the left side cover (page 138).
- 3. Remove the fuse box cover.
