
- 3. If the drive chain is found to require adjustment, the procedure is as follows:
 - a. Remove the rear axle nut cotter pin ② and loosen the rear axle nut
 ③.
 - b. Turn the adjusting nuts (4) on both the right and left chain adjusters to increase or decrease chain tension.
 Align the chain adjuster index marks (5) with the reference marks (6) on

- both sides of the rear fork.
- c. Tighten the rear axle nut and secure the nut with a new cotter pin.
- d. Recheck drive chain tension.
- e. Rear brake pedal free travel is affected when repositioning the rear wheel to adjust drive chain tension. Check rear brake pedal free travel and adjust as necessary (page 53).
