
## Other Checks:

Check the brake cable for kinks or signs of wear that could cause sticking or failure. Lubricate the brake cable with a commercially available cable lubricant to prevent wear and corrosion. Make sure the brake arm, spring, and fasteners are in good condition.

## **CLUTCH**

- 1. Make sure the ignition switch is OFF.
- Loosen the lock nut (1), and turn the clutch adjuster
  (2) counterclockwise until you feel slight resistance.
  Then turn the adjuster 1/4 turn clockwise, and tighten the lock nut to hold the adjuster in this position.
- 3. After adjustment, start the engine and test ride the BIG RED to be certain that the clutch is operating properly.
