- Remove the oil filter cover (Fig. 4-13) by removing the screws.
 Let the remaining oil drain out.
 Discard the oil filter (2).
- 4. Check that the oil filter cover O-rings (3) are in good condition and then install a new oil filter. Use the Honda oil filter or an equivalent filter specified for your model. Other filters not specified for your model may not filter impurities properly.
- Install the filter with the rubber seal facing out, away from the engine. You will see "OUT-SIDE" on the filter body, near the seal.

CAUTION:

Improper installation of the oil filter can cause serious engine damage.

6. Reinstall the oil filter cover (1), making sure the bolts are tightened securely.


