## High Air Temperature

35 °C (95 °F) or above

- 1. Do not use the choke.
- 2. With the throttle slightly open, press the starter button (1).



## Low Air Temperature

10 °C (50 °F) or below

1. Follow the procedure for "Normal Air Temperature".

## NOTE:

When air temperature is below -15 °C (5 °F), push the starting primer knob two or three times (page 18).

## **CAUTION:**

- \* Extended use of the choke may impair piston and cylinder wall lubrication and shorten the life of the engine.
- \* Do not race the engine during the warm-up period.

  Racing a cold engine wastes fuel and increases engine wear.

If the engine doesn't start after pushing the starter button several times, use the recoil starter.
