# Starting & Stopping the Engine

#### Starting the engine after a stall during riding or after a fall:

- 1. Shift the transmission into neutral.
- 2. Push the hot start lever and kick-start the engine. (Do not open the throttle.)
- 3. As soon as the engine starts, release the hot start lever.

# Starting the engine excessively charged with fuel by throttle blipping or other reasons:

- 1. Shift the transmission into neutral.
- 2. With the throttle fully opened, repeat kickstarter operation approximately 10 times very slowly to discharge excessive fuel from the engine.
- 3. Push the hot start lever and kick-start the engine (Do not open the throttle).
- 4. As soon as the engine starts, release the hot start lever.

## How to Stop the Engine

#### Normal Engine Stop

To stop the engine, make sure the transmission is in neutral, and turn the ignition switch OFF ( $\bigcirc$ ).

The engine stop switch should normally remain in the RUN (  $\bigcirc$  ) position even when the engine is OFF.

### **Emergency Engine Stop**

To stop the engine in an emergency, use the engine stop switch. To operate, move the switch to either OFF ( $\bigotimes$ ) position.
