
# **Starting & Stopping the Engine**

### High Air Temperature 35°C (95°F) or above

#### LEFT HANDLEBAR



- 1. Do not use the choke
- 2. With the throttle closed, press the start button (1).

## Low Air Temperature 10°C (50°F) or below

Follow the procedure for "Normal Air Temperature."

When air temperature is below  $-15^{\circ}\text{C}$  (5°F), push the starting primer knob two or three times (page 35).

## NOTICE

Extended use of the choke may impair piston and cylinder wall lubrication and shorten the life of the engine.

Do not race the engine during the warm-up period. Racing a cold engine wastes fuel and increases engine wear.
