STARTING THE ENGINE

Preparation

- 1. Select a level surface and lock the parking brake (page 34) before starting the engine.
- 2. Turn the fuel valve (1) and ignition switch (2) to ON.
- 3. Make sure the engine stop switch (3) is at RUN.
- Make sure that the transmission is in neutral by depressing the gear shift pedal and checking that the neutral indicator (4) is at "N".

The neutral indicator is located a few inches above the left footpeg.


