IDLE SPEED


Refer to the Safety Precautions on page 74.

The engine must be at normal operating temperature for accurate idle speed adjustment. 10 minutes of stop-and-go riding is sufficient.

- 1. Warm up the engine, shift to neutral and place the motorcycle on its stand.
- 2. Turn the bolt (1) 90° counterclockwise and pull the right lower cowl (2).
- 3. Adjust idle speed with the throttle stop screw (3).

Idle speed (In neutral):
