Standard oil level:

170 mm (6.7 in)

To lower the oil level (decrease volume), use a syringe. Add oil with a graduated beaker for accurate measurements.

The recommended oil level range is:

164 mm (6.5 in) to 194 mm (7.6 in).

NOTE:

- Increase or decrease oil in increments of 5 cm³ (0.17 US oz, 0.18 Imp oz).
- To prevent fork damage, do not fill past the recommended maximum level. Do not use a level lower than the recommended minimum to prevent poor performance.
- 5. Be sure the oil level is the same in both fork tubes.
- 6. Clean and dry the fork spring with a lint free cloth. Install the fork spring and fork cap bolt. Torque the fork cap bolt to:

30 N·m (3.0 kg-m, 22 ft-lb).
