
Inspect the sprocket teeth for wear or damage.



Standard sprocket sizes:

Drive sprocket (engine)	Driven sprocket (rear wheel)
13 teeth	47 teeth


NOTE:

* If the drive chain or sprockets are excessively worn or damaged, they should be replaced. Never use a new chain with worn sprockets; rapid chain wear will result.

Adjustment:

If the drive chain requires adjustment, the procedure is as follows:

- 1. Loosen the rear axle nut (1) while holding the axle.
- 2. Turn both right and left adjusters (2) equally to increase or decrease chain slack.
- After adjusting, be sure the same adjuster index marks align with the stopper pins (3) on both sides of the swingarm.
