

For safe riding

Parking

- Turn the steering wheel left and park the vehicle on a level surface. The following positions will cause the vehicle to fall from imbalance.
- Parking with the steering wheel turned right.
- Parking on slopes, metal/gravel roads, uneven surfaces, and soft ground.

- When parking in any of the position/places listed above is unavoidable, take the necessary precautions to provide safety and to prevent the motorcycle from moving or toppling.

Using the side-stand for parking

- Park on level, stable ground.
- Choose a safe parking spot that will not interfere with pedestrian or road traffic.
- The exhaust pipes will become heated during use. Park the motorcycle in a safe place to avoid contact with people.
- Do not touch the exhaust pipe or the engine while the engine is running.
