Is Your Motorcycle Ready to Ride?

Before each ride, it's important to inspect your motorcycle and make sure any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tire, can be a major inconvenience.

AWARNING

Improperly maintaining this motorcycle or failing to correct a problem before riding can cause a crash in which you can be seriously hurt or killed.

Always perform a pre-ride inspection before every ride and correct any problems.

Pre-ride Inspection

Check the following items before you get on the motorcycle:

Tires Look at the tires. If a tire

& appears low, use an air pressure

Wheels gauge to check its pressure. Also
look for signs of excessive wear
(page 152) or damage to the
tires and wheels

Chain Check the condition of the chain.
Adjust slack and lubricate as
needed (page 161).
