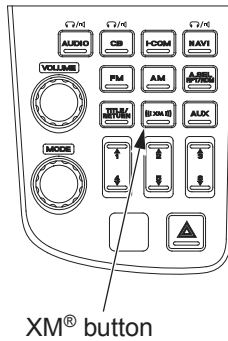

Your motorcycle is capable of receiving XM<sup>®</sup> Radio anywhere in the United States, except Hawaii, Alaska and Puerto Rico. XM<sup>®</sup> is a registered trade mark of Sirius XM Radio<sup>®</sup>, Inc.

XM<sup>®</sup> Radio receives signals from two satellites to produce clear, high-quality digital reception. It offers many channels in several categories. Along with a large selection of different types of music, XM<sup>®</sup> Radio also allows you to view channel and category selections in the audio display.

## Receiving XM<sup>®</sup> Radio Service

If your XM<sup>®</sup> Radio service has expired or you purchased your motorcycle from a previous owner, you can listen to a sampling of the broadcasts available on XM<sup>®</sup> Radio. With the ignition switch in the ACCESSORY or the ON position, press the XM<sup>®</sup> button. A variety of music types and styles will play.
