## **Rear Differential Oil**

## **Changing Oil**

Refer to Safety Precautions on page 79.

Change the oil with the rear differential at normal operating temperature to assure complete and rapid draining.

- 1. Park the Honda MUV on a firm, level surface.
- 2. Place an oil drain pan under the oil drain plug.
- 3. Remove the oil fill cap and the drain plug.
- 4. After the oil has completely drained, reinstall the drain plug with a new sealing washer and tighten it to the specified torque:
  - 9 lbf·ft (12 N·m, 1.2 kgf·m)
- 5. Fill the rear differential with the recommended oil.
  - 15.7 US oz (465 cm<sup>3</sup>)
- 6. Make sure the oil level is at the lower edge of the oil fill inspection hole.
- 7. Apply a thin coat of grease to a new O-ring, and insert it into the oil fill cap groove.
- 8. Install and tighten oil fill cap to the specified torque:
  - 9 lbf•ft (12 N•m , 1.2 kgf•m)
- 9. Pour the drained oil into a suitable container and dispose of it in an approved manner (page 174).
