
## **NOTICE**

## **Spark Plug Inspection & Replacement**

Refer to Safety Precautions on page 81.

- 1. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug base.
- 2. Disconnect the spark plug cap (1). Take care to avoid damaging the spark plug wire when disconnecting the cap.
- 3. Using a spark plug wrench provided in the tool kit, remove the spark plug.
