## Is Your ATV Ready to Ride?

Fuel Check the level and add fuel (page 118) if

needed. Also make sure the fuel fill cap is

securely fastened. Check for leaks.

Tires Use a gauge to check the air pressure. Adjust if

needed. Also look for signs of damage or

excessive wear (page 170).

Drivetrain Boots Check for damage (page 175).

Guards Check for damage (page 174).

Nuts & Bolts Check the wheels to see that the axle nuts are

tightened. Use a wrench to make sure all accessible nuts, bolts, and fasteners are tight.

Underbody & Check for, and remove, any dirt, vegetation or

Exhaust System other debris that could be a fire hazard or interfere with the proper operation of the

vehicle.

Air Cleaner Housing Check for deposits in the drain tube. If

Drain Tube necessary, clean the tube (page 142) and check

the air cleaner housing.

Leaks, Loose Parts Walk around your ATV and look for anything

that appears unusual, such as a leak or loose

cable.

Cable Check the cable housings for wear. Check the

fittings for looseness. Replace or tighten as

needed.

Lights Make sure the headlight, brake light and

taillight are working properly.
