Engine Oil

3. Pour the drained oil into a suitable container and dispose of it in an approved manner (page 160).

NOTICE

Improper disposal of drained fluids is harmful to the environment.

Add Engine Oil:

- 1. Check that the drain bolt sealing washer is in good condition. If necessary, replace the sealing washer.
- 2. Reinstall the oil drain bolt with a new sealing washer, and tighten it to the specified torque:
 - 17 lbf·ft (24 N·m, 2.4 kgf·m)
- 3. Fill the crankcase with the recommended grade oil approximately:
 - 0.7 US qt (0.7 ℓ)
- 4. Reinstall the oil fill cap/dipstick.
- 5. Start the engine and let it idle for 3–5 minutes.
- 6. Stop the engine and check the oil level. Make sure the oil is between the upper and lower level marks on the oil fill cap/dipstick. If necessary, add more oil but do not overfill.
- 7. Check that there are no oil leaks.

If a torque wrench is not used for installation, see your dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly.
