- 1. To adjust slack, loosen the rear axle holder fixing bolts (1).
- 2. Turn the adjusting nut (2) to decrease or increase chain slack.
- 3. Retighten the rear axle holder fixing bolts.
- 4. Rear axle holder fixing bolts torque:

65 lbf·ft (88 N·m, 9.0 kgf·m)

If a torque wrench is not used for this installation, see your dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly.
